

## **Description:**

A compact vining selection that is perfect for indoor containers and hanging baskets; features heart or arrow shaped leaves with a lime to golden base color, highlighted with pink veins; easy to grow, and a perfect accent plant for low to medium light

## **Features & Attributes**

Falling Arrows Golden Allusion Arrowhead Vine's attractive heart-shaped leaves remain lime green in color with distinctive pink veins and tinges of gold throughout the year on a plant with a spreading habit of growth.



## **Planting & Growing**

When grown indoors, Falling Arrows Golden Allusion Arrowhead Vine can be expected to grow to be about 6 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 24 inches. It grows at a fast rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 10 years. This houseplant performs well in both bright or indirect sunlight and strong artificial light, and can therefore be situated in almost any well-lit room or location. It prefers to grow in average to moist soil. The surface of the soil shouldn't be allowed to dry out completely, and so you should expect to water this plant once and possibly even twice each week. Be aware that your particular watering schedule may vary depending on its location in the room, the pot size, plant size and other conditions; if in doubt, ask one of our experts in the store for advice. It will benefit from a regular feeding with a general-purpose fertilizer with every second or third watering. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in rich soil. Contact the store for specific recommendations on pre-mixed potting soil for this plant. Be warned that parts of this plant are known to be toxic to humans and animals, so special care should be exercised if growing it around children and pets.
