### Pink Dwarf Japanese Skimmia *Skimmia japonica* 'Pink Dwarf'

Height: 30 inches

Spread: 30 inches

Sunlight: ●

Hardiness Zone: 7b

#### Description:

A compact, mound forming, bushy male variety with leathery, dark green aromatic leaves, and dense panicles of sweetly fragrant, pink flushed, creamy white flowers in spring; excellent for low borders and containers

#### Ornamental Features

Pink Dwarf Japanese Skimmia features showy clusters of fragrant creamy white flowers with pink overtones at the ends of the branches in mid spring, which emerge from distinctive rose flower buds. It has attractive dark green evergreen foliage which emerges chartreuse in spring. The glossy narrow leaves are highly ornamental and remain dark green throughout the winter.

#### Landscape Attributes

Pink Dwarf Japanese Skimmia is a multi-stemmed evergreen shrub with a mounded form. Its average texture blends into the landscape, but can be balanced by one or two finer or coarser trees or shrubs for an effective composition.

This shrub will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers. It has no significant negative characteristics.

Pink Dwarf Japanese Skimmia is recommended for the following landscape applications;

- Accent
- Mass Planting
- General Garden Use
- Container Planting

### Planting & Growing

Pink Dwarf Japanese Skimmia will grow to be about 30 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 30 inches. It has a low canopy. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 30 years.

This shrub should be grown in a location with partial shade or which is shaded from the hot afternoon sun. It prefers to grow in average to moist conditions, and shouldn't be allowed to dry out. This plant does not require much in the way of fertilizing once established. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in rich soils. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This is a selected variety of a species not originally from North America.

Pink Dwarf Japanese Skimmia makes a fine choice for the outdoor landscape, but it is also well-suited for use in outdoor pots and containers. It can be used either as 'filler' or as a 'thriller' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination, depending on the height and form of the other plants used in the container planting. It is even sizeable enough that it can be grown alone in a suitable container. Note that when grown in a container, it may not perform exactly as indicated on the tag - this is to be expected. Also note that when growing plants in outdoor containers and baskets, they may require more frequent waterings than they would in the yard or garden. Be aware that in our climate, most plants cannot be expected to survive the winter if left in containers outdoors, and this plant is no exception.
